***We make peanut butter in Severn and Edenton, NC production facilities. We have no issues at these locations. We produce peanut butter under our brand names of Hampton Farms and Jimbo's Jumbos as well as private label brands. No product we produce is involved with the recall in any way.***

***Our testing Lab, JLA , is an independent company. They are certified by The State of North Carolina and in the process of being certified by ISO17025. JLA is also certified by several large private companies.***
